What is Kinship?

Kinship is intended to provide support to relative and non-relative caregivers who are taking care of children full-time. Families access needed services, expand family support systems and ultimately reduce stress to promote family stability.



People have always cared for their relative and non-relative children. However, most have done so with little or no formal help.
